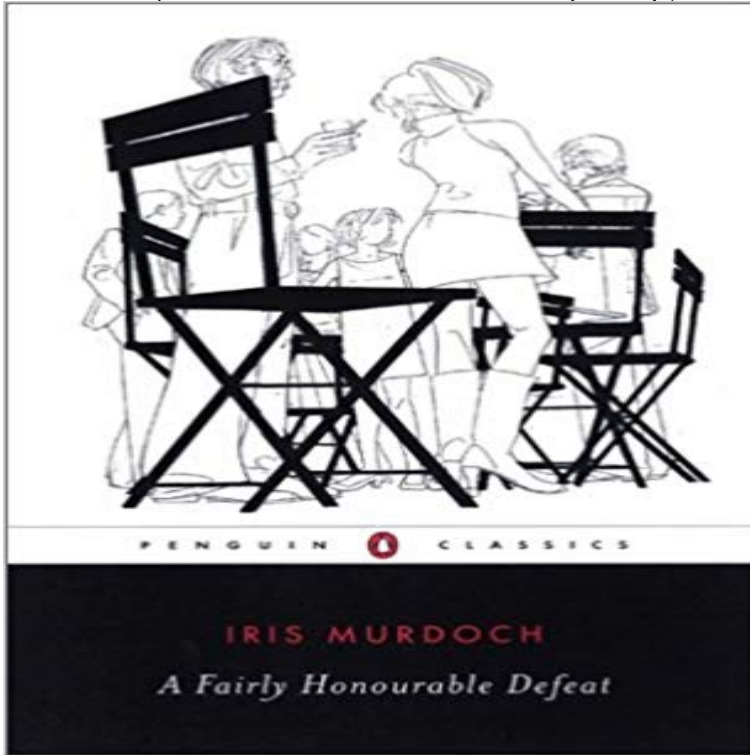


## A Fairly Honourable Defeat (Penguin Twentieth Century Classics)
