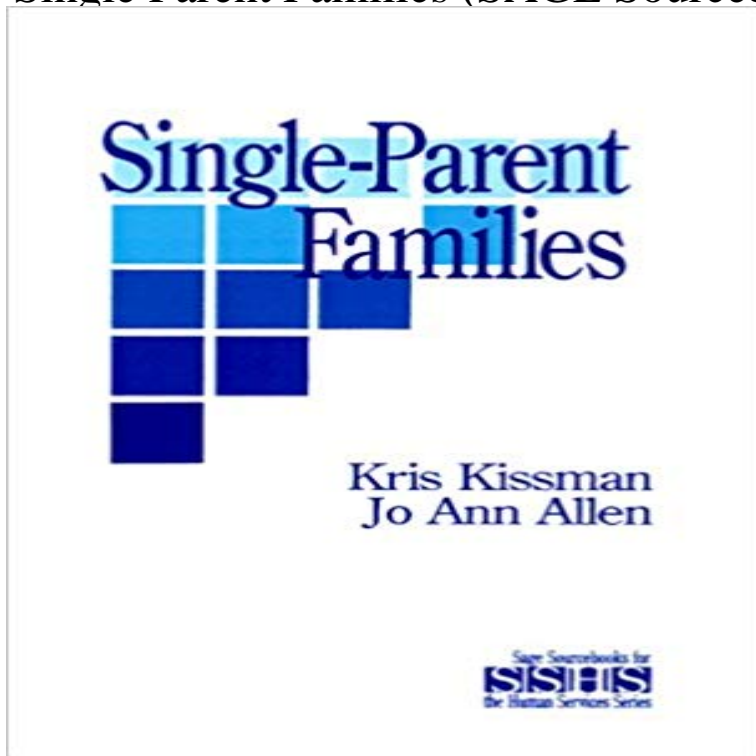


Single Parent Families (SAGE Sourcebooks for the Human Services)
