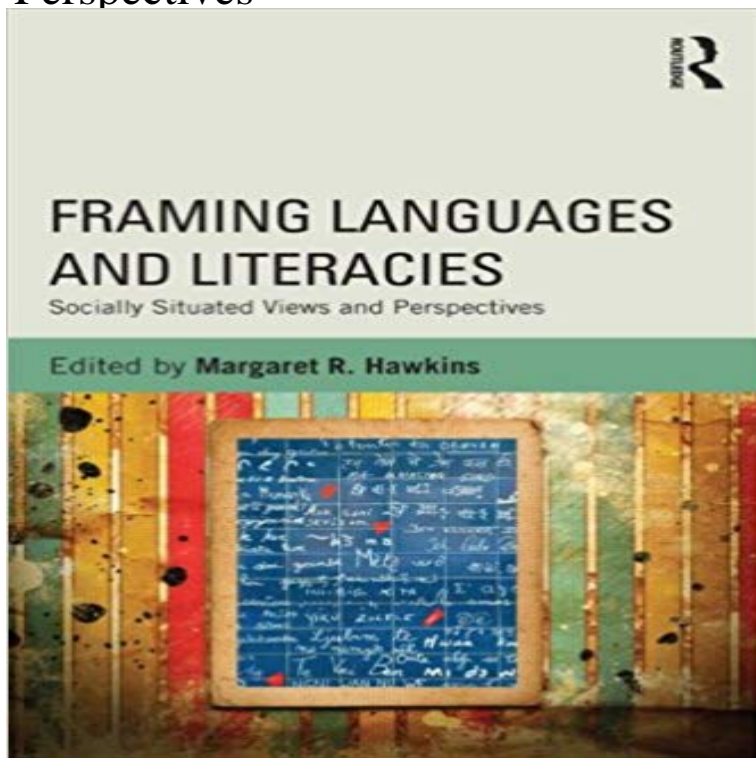


Framing Languages and Literacies: Socially Situated Views and Perspectives
