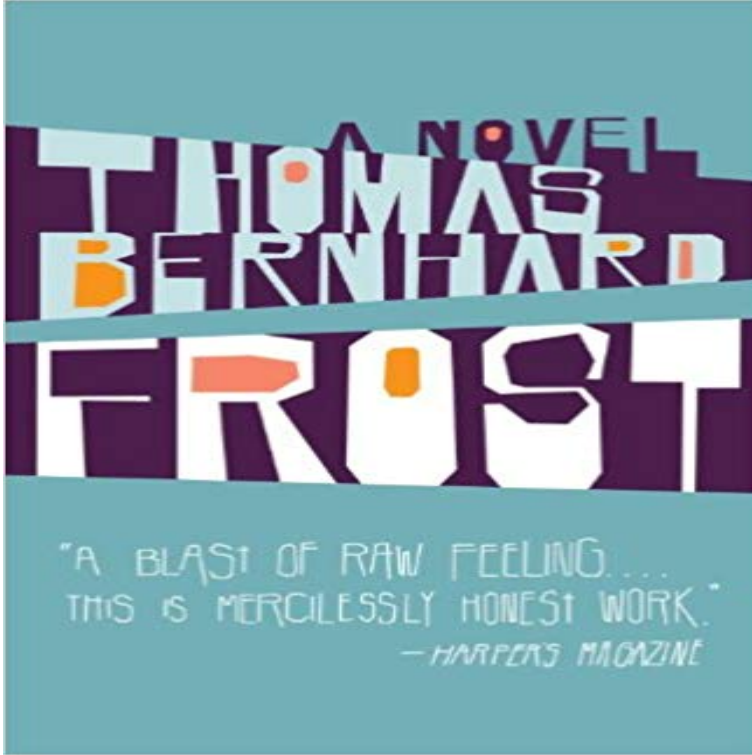


Frost: A Novel (Vintage International)
