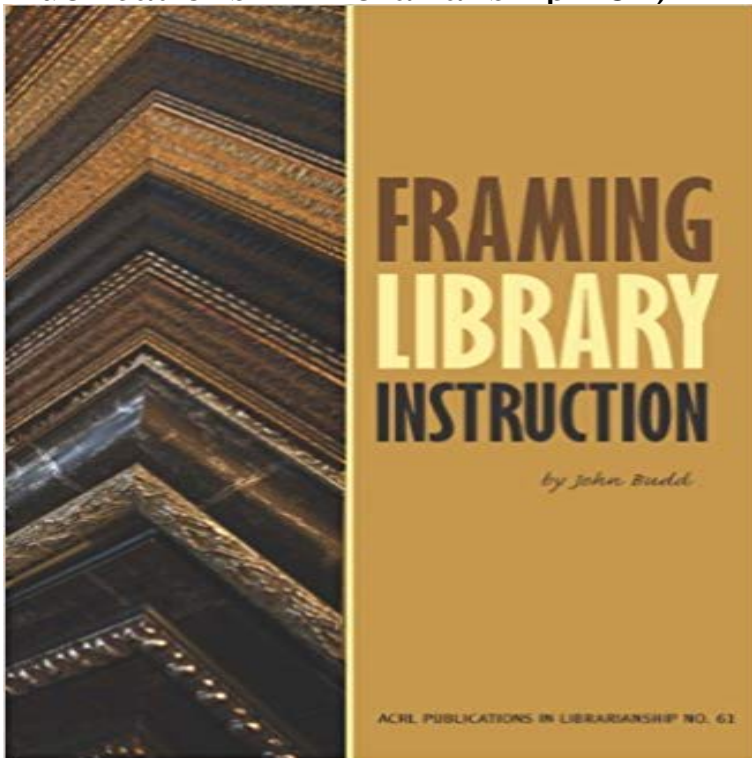


# Framing Library Instruction: A View from Within and Without (ACRL Publications in Librarianship #61)
