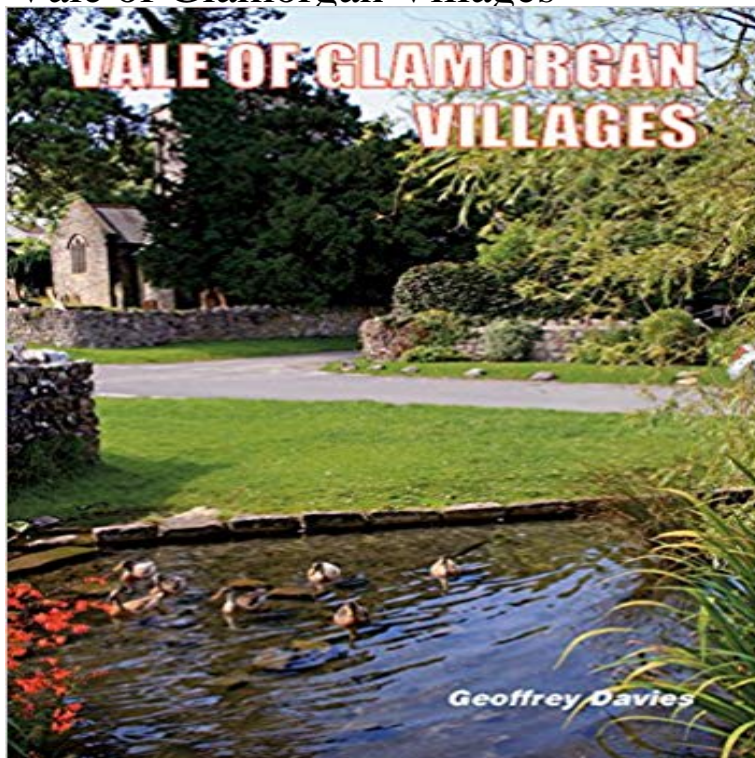


## Vale of Glamorgan Villages
