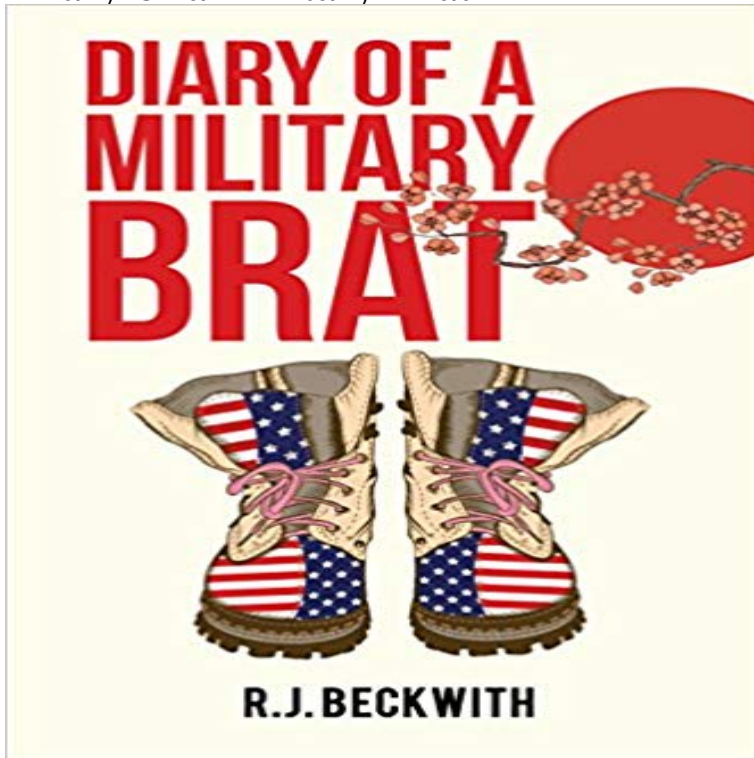


Diary of a Military Brat
