


# Tunnels

However, the experiences that they shared during the winter and spring of 1959, would be unequalled in intensity, and would serve to cement their relationship forever. Bored with the routines of normal adolescent existence, Tom and Jim began exploring the endless railroad system, which once occupied Jersey City and the surrounding Meadowlands. Their adventures became progressively more brazen and more dangerous, often threatening their lives. Apparently unconcerned, the young duo tempted fate regularly, while continuously seeking the ultimate adrenalin rush. Matters reach a new level of intrigue when Tom shares a secret with Jim, and two young girls become involved in their escapades. The love interests force a stabilizing effect on the two friends and their activities, but the tranquility is short lived.
