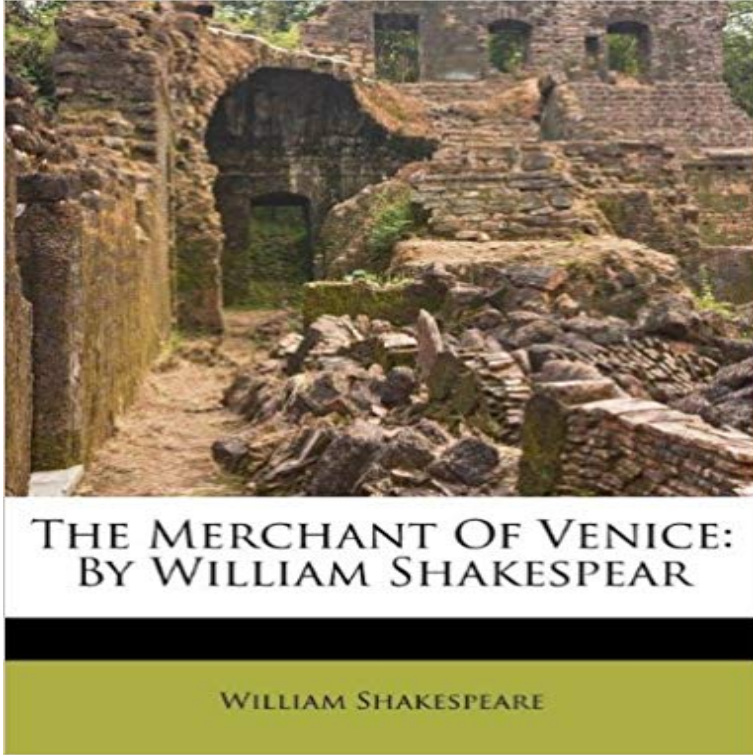


The Merchant of Venice: By William Shakespear
