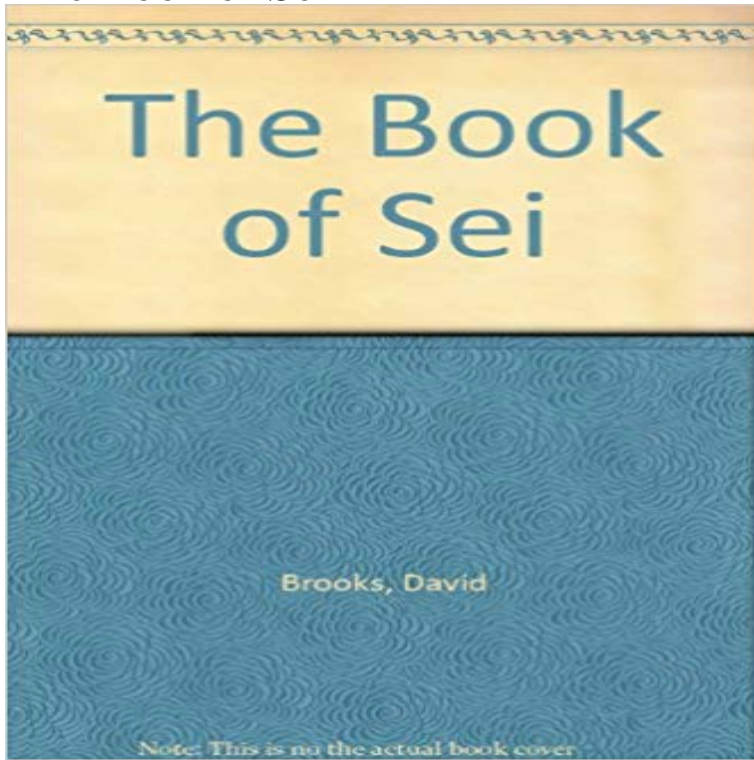


The Book of Sei
