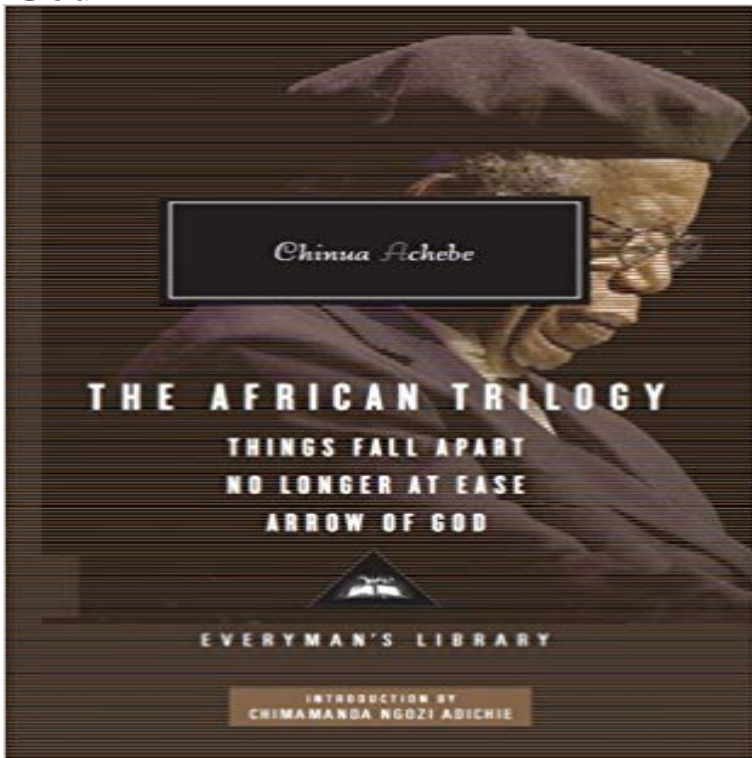

In *No Longer at Ease*, Okonkwo's grandson, Obi, educated in England, returns to a civil-service job in colonial Lagos, only to clash with the ruling elite to which he now believes he belongs. *Arrow of God* is set in the 1920s and explores the conflict from the two points of view - often, but not always, opposing - of Ezeulu, an Igbo priest, and Captain Winterbottom, a British district officer. In spare and lucid prose, Achebe tells a universal tale of personal and moral struggle in a changing world which continues to resonate in Africa today and has captured the imaginations of readers everywhere.
