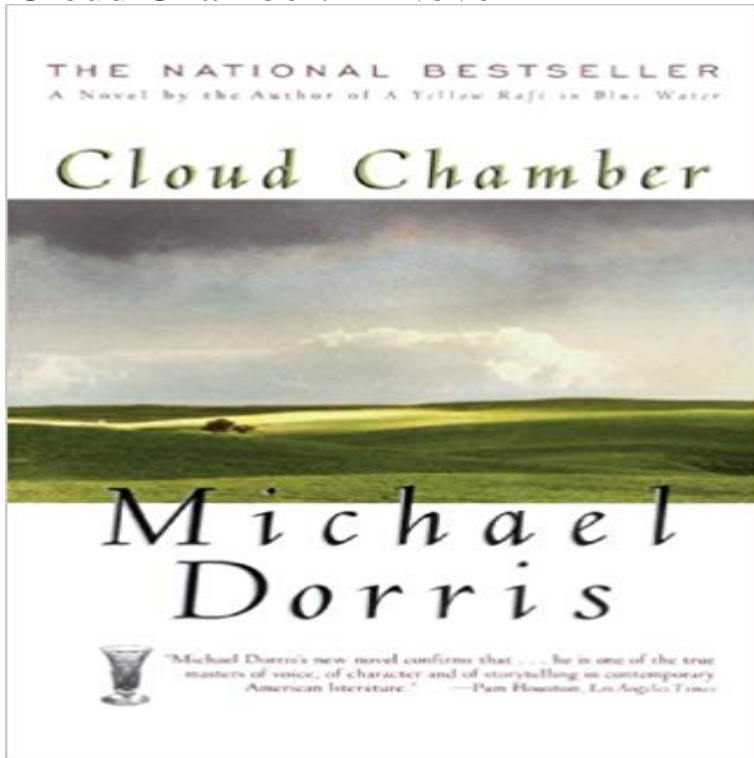


Cloud Chamber: A Novel
