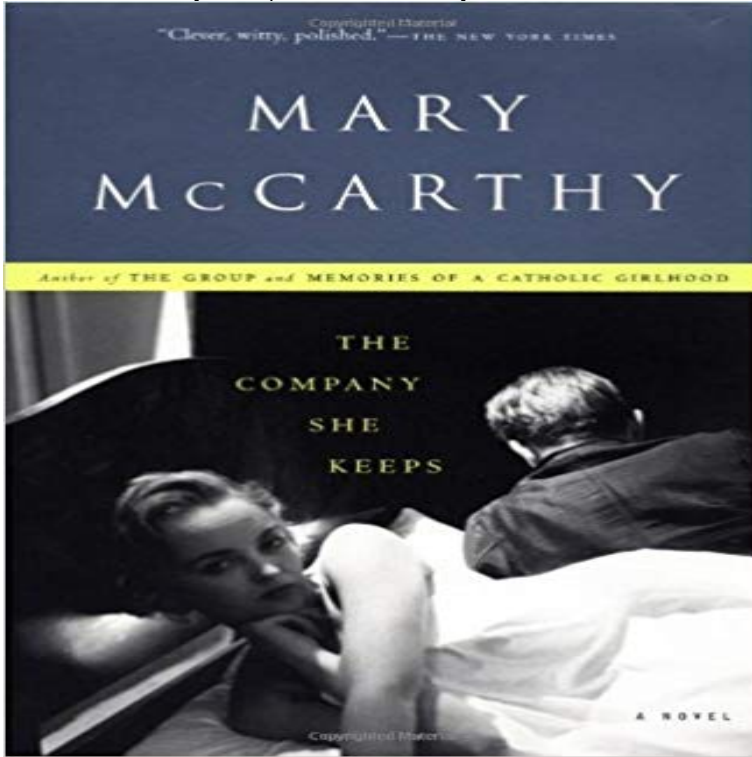


The Company She Keeps
