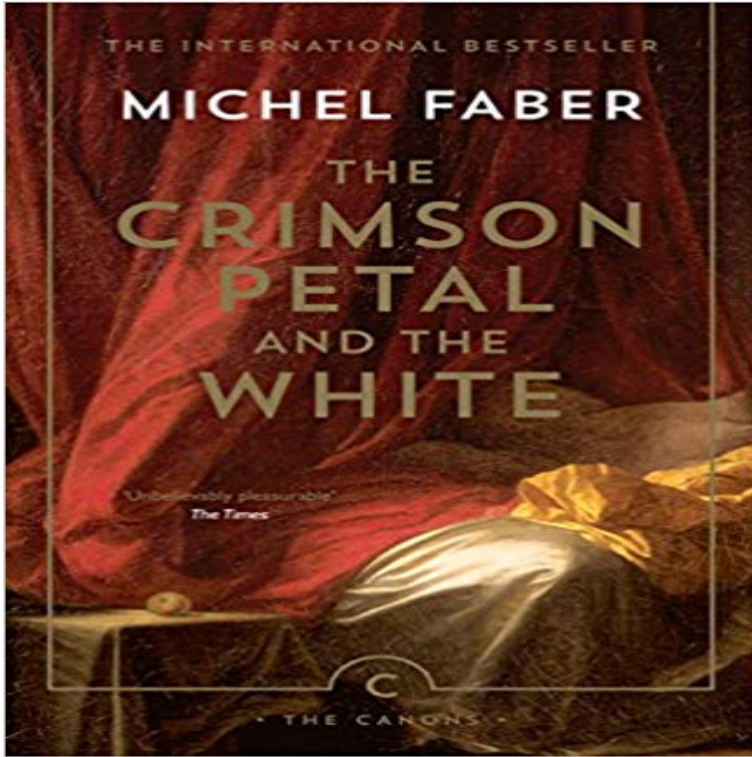


The Crimson Petal and the White
