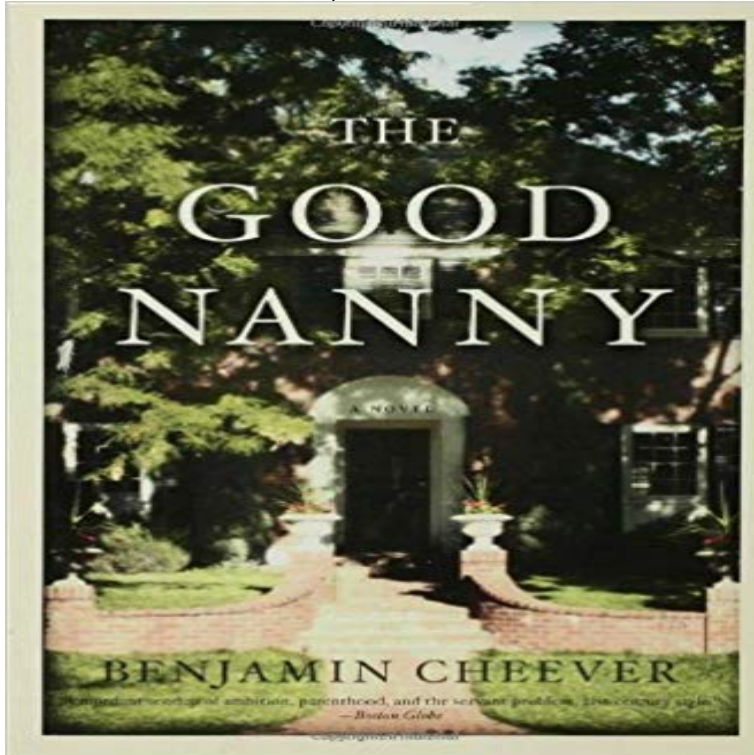


The Good Nanny: A Novel
