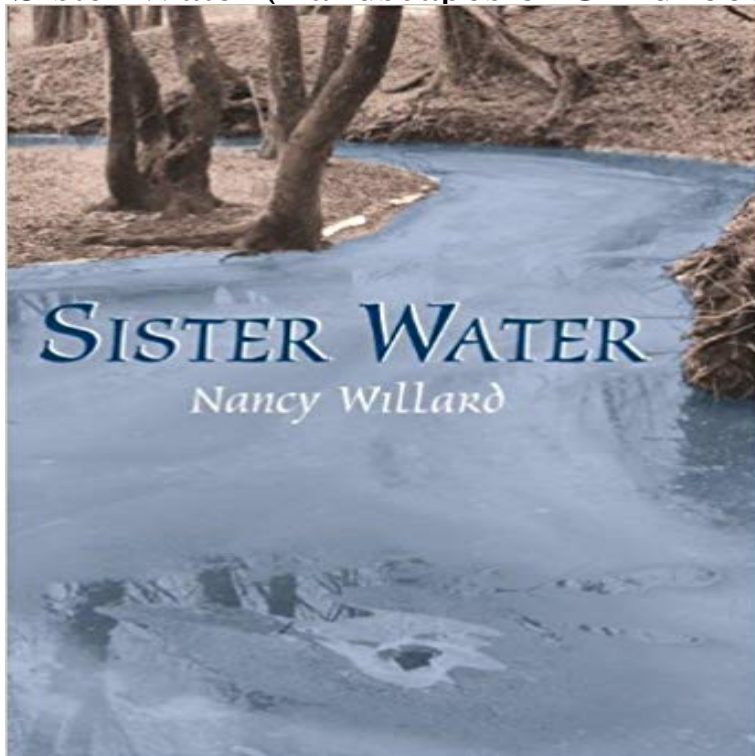


Sister Water (Landscapes of Childhood Series)

Just as Jessies aging mind begins to wander, Ellens husband dies in a car accident and the Woolman family begins a new journey led by two very different men: Harvey Mack, a developer with an eye on the Woolman property and the grieving Ellen, and Sam Theopolis, a mystic hired to care for Jessie. Sam becomes both Harveys rival and a healing presence for the family until a crisis descends and he, too, needs the protection of the Woolmans innocent belief in the saving power of love. Combining sorrow and grief with considerable light-hearted wit and eccentric characters, *Sister Water* is a novel that will reach old and young readers alike. Through her lyrical prose, author Nancy Willard draws on the rich style of magical realism to create a narrative flow that is at once powerful and seductive.
